In 1981 he won the George Deveine Award for his play *Outskirts*, and in 1982 he was appointed Writer-in-Residence at the Royal Court Theatre. In 1984 he wrote *My Beautiful Laundrette*, which received an Oscar nomination for Best Screenplay. His second screenplay *Sammie and Rosie Get Laid* (1987) was followed by *London Kills Me* (1991) Whitbread Prize for Best First Novel in 1990 and was made into a four-part drama series by the BBC in 1993. His version of Brecht's *Mother Courage* has been produced by the Royal Shakespeare Company and the Royal National Theatre. His second novel, *The Black Album*, was published in 1995. With Jon Savage he edited *The Faber Book of Pop* (1995). His collection of short stories, *Love is a Blue Time*, was published in 1997. His story *My Son the Fanatic*, from that collection, was adapted for film and released in 1998. *Intimacy*, his third novel, was published in 1998. His play *Sleep With Me* premiered at the Royal National Theatre in 1999. His second collection of stories, *Midnight All Day*, was published in 2000.
